

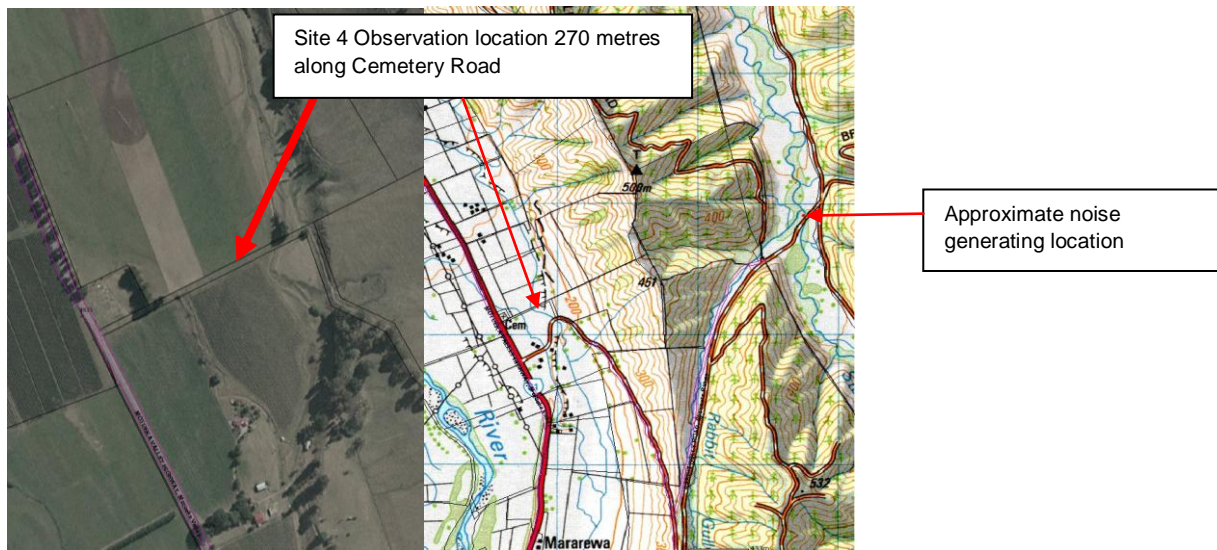

**Subject:** Supplementary report on RM100848: Adcock and Donaldson properties Ltd: Create and Operate a Motorsport Park at Stanley Brook.

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This report records the details of noise assessments carried out on 22 December 2011 from site 4. No interpretation of the data gathered is made in this report.

Site 4 noise observation location was approximately 270 metres along Cemetery Road from Motueka Valley Highway.  
NZ map grid reference approximately N2496824 and E5977200

The noise observation location was approximately 2 km as the crow flies from the noise generating site (site 1). However there is a significant ridge of 400 metres between the noise generating and noise observation locations, meaning the ridge is 220 metres above site 4 elevation. No line of sight exists between the locations.



Weather conditions were dry, fine, 50% cloud cover, light breeze to start then picking up to a breeze causing leaves on the trees to rustle.

The background noise climate was predominately rural in nature, with insect noise, birds chirping, and occasional cow and sheep noises. Vehicles passing along the Motueka Valley Highway were faintly audible from site 4.

Observations were made by the writer between 11am and 1pm. Radio contact was made before and after every motorsport noise generating session, and observations of the noise were specifically made at these times.

On all occasions there was no motorsport noise audible at site 4. The only noise observed was the dominant rural noise of insects, birds and occasional animal sounds.
